## **Eligibility**

This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com.

A warm up area, consisting of regulation TDAA equipment, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

**Obstacle Familiarization** will be provided on Saturday and Sunday mornings 15 minutes prior to judging for all dogs and handlers. **No toys or treats may be used in the ring during familiarization.** 

#### **Awards**

Ribbons will be awarded for  $1^{st}$  through  $3^{rd}$  in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Fast track dogs will only get qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels. One High in Trial will be offered each day to one dog/handler team that competes in all classes per day. HIT to be determined by highest cumulative scores, then fastest cumulative time if score is tied.

## Move-Ups

Pre-entry move-ups requests must be in writing but may be sent via email to the trial secretary at <a href="LKO1014@yahoo.com">LKO1014@yahoo.com</a> at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

## **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be scored with dogs of their measured height. TDAA height divisions are:

- 2" jump height: for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers (or with body type or veterans exemptions)
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers;
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers;
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers;
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

**ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD** must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

TWO MEASUREMENT BY TDAA JUDGES are needed to show a dog in the TDAA without requiring measurement.

**Disabled Handlers:** A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

## **Fast Track Program**

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score but no higher than the comparable level. You must submit a copy of certificates from the organization in which the higher level title was earned for each dog.

A dog eligible for Fast Tracking may only move up one class at a time and not skip over a class whether or not they met the criteria for a higher class in the first test. A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement within the class that he received the qualifying score and will not earn a title or receive a title certificate for that level.

Please mark the classes that apply on the Trial Entry form and submit an additional \$8.00 with your entry (payable to SSPC). Payment of this fee is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. The Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial even if it was paid for a previous trial.

#### **Obstacles**

The following is a list of obstacles to be used:

A-frame (8', slatted) Single and winged jumps Table (37" x 39")

Teeter (10' plank, no slats) Dog Walk (8' planks, slatted) Weave poles (24" separation)

Open (Pipe) Tunnel (24" diameter)

Tire Jump (20" opening)

All obstacles meet the TDAA equipment size requirements.

#### **Notice to Exhibitors**

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, e.g., the warm-up area and the designated off leash area.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at <a href="https://www.k9TDAA.com">www.k9TDAA.com</a>.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dog will be subject to dismissal with no refund of their entry fees.

No dogs shall be left at the trial site overnight.

TDAA and the Sunshine State Papillon Club and The Dog Training Club of Tampa are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.

Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or un-prescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the building the day of a TDAA event.

#### **Directions to the Trial Site**

From the North – Take I75 South and get on I275 where it splits just south of the Exit at Hwy 56.

Continue on 1275 to the Hillsborough Avenue Exit. Make a right (West) onto Hillsborough Avenue (US 92).

Follow Hillsborough to Lois (about a 1/4 of a mile west of the Dale Mabry overpass).

Make a left at the light onto N. Lois.

The club is two blocks south on the left at 4817 N. Lois.

From the West/South - Take 275 North to Dale Mabry East (North Bound).

Going North on Dale Mabry make a left (West) onto Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd which is just after the stadium. Make a right onto Lois.

The club will be on the right in a couple blocks or so.

From the East – Take I 4 to I 275 to Dale Mabry East (Northbound).

Going North on Dale Mabry make a left (West) onto Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd which is just after the stadium.

Make a right onto Lois.

The club will be on the right in a couple blocks or so.

# Class Information Standard Classes

**Beginner** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from another organization.

**Intermediate** – Dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior** – Dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

#### **Games Classes**

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**FEO (For Exhibition Only)** – FEO runs are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO participants cannot repeat any obstacles; no training is permitted in the ring.

## **Games Class Descriptions**

The following are some brief descriptions of the games offered at this trial. We encourage you to enter the games classes even if they seem unfamiliar to you – we are sure that you will have lots of fun!

Judge's briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings. The judge will provide a thorough briefing to exhibitors and hard copies of the complete rules and qualifying requirements will be available. Example briefings are available on TDAA's Web site at www.k9tdaa.com.

Chutes and Ladders – The objective of the game is negotiate a course of tunnels and contact obstacles. Time starts when the dog crosses the start line, and ends when the dog crosses the finish line. Chutes and Ladders is scored time plus faults. The dog and handler team run the numbered course, with faults assessed for off courses or missed contacts.

**Jumpers** – Jumpers courses consist only of hurdles and tunnels. The dog is required to run the course in the sequence indicated by the judge. Off-courses and knocked bars are always faulted.

**Rabbit Express** – The objective of Rabbit Express is to summon the inner speed in every dog, while at the same time creating an opportunity for the dog that approaches life from the point of view of the tortoise to prevail.

Rabbit Express is a numbered, steeplechase-style speed course that dogs will need to run like the proverbial rabbit. The goal is to negotiate the Rabbit Express sequence as quickly as possible. However, there is a twist, (of course!) that the wise tortoise may take advantage of. Somewhere along the course two Rabbit Holes will be hidden. The reckless rabbit who falls into the hole must navigate a detour sequence to dig itself out and get back on the Rabbit Express. That could be just the chance the Tortoise needs to pass right by! No refusal faults shall be called, however all obstacles must be performed, else a 20 point failure to perform fault shall be assessed.

**12 Tone Row** – The purpose of Twelve-Tone Row is to accumulate as many points as possible. Each obstacle has the value of its number on course. The same obstacle may have different values, depending on the direction in which it is performed.

The handler may direct his dog to perform the obstacles in any order he chooses. If the dog chooses the obstacle to perform, the handler will have to live with it. Only 12 obstacles may be performed. The 12th must be the weave poles, in either direction. The dog and handler team will earn the assigned point values of the obstacles taken. No points are awarded for a repeated obstacle.

Minuet – The dog and handler have 50 seconds. Repeat the sequence as a continuous loop until the expiration of time. The judge may specify that the dog has to cross a finish line or go to a table to stop time after the whistle blows to end scoring. One point is earned for each completion of the loop. One decimal point is earned for each jump in an uncompleted loop when time expires. If the dog drops a bar, the handler must stop and reset the bar. If the dog goes off course, one point is lost. Counting of the loop will not continue until the dog returns to the next on-course jump.

All pre-entries must be postmarked by 6:00 p.m., April 29, 2017. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), postmarked by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to Sunshine State Papillon Club (SSPC).

You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

Entries will not be accepted without fees. **No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery.** All entries must be submitted on an official TDAA Agility Entry Form, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the TDAA Agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.

All fees must be paid in U.S. funds. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before May 5, 2017.
